Unopposed motion for joint trials is determined as hereinafter set forth.

The within actions seek recovery for damages allegedly sustained by Plaintiffs' as a result of a fire which occurred on March 18, 1999, at a cooperative building, located at **55 Monroe Boulevard, Long Beach, New York.**

Prior to the fire, there were approximately 95 units in the building.

Plaintiffs' in all of the actions were either tenants in the building on March 18, 1999, or subrogees' of tenants', who suffered property damage as a result of fire, smoke and water.

It is alleged in the various pleadings that Defendant, 55 Monroe Owners Corporation, owned the building, and Defendant, Total Community Management, managed the building on the date of the fire. The Defendant, DJR and BR Trust of 1988, the Coooperative sponsor, was the record owner of several of the Plaintiff's apartments on the date of the fire. Defendant, Schneider Construction Corporation was retained by Defendant, 55 Monroe Owners Corporation, to perform construction and renovation services at the premises, including repairs to the roof.

It is alleged inter alia that:

(a) Defendant, Schneider was negligent in the use and storage of

propane at the premises, and that on March 18, 1999, a fire caused by a propane torch belonging to Schneider, ignited part of the roof at the premises.

- (b) Defendants, Total Community Management and 55 Monroe Boulevard Owners Corporation were negligent in the maintenance and management of the property.
- (c) Defendant, DJR and BR Trust of 1988, was negligent in the ownership and maintenance of its respective apartments.

There shall be a **JOINT TRIAL** of actions No. 1 through 28, inclusive. Opening and closing statements shall be subject to the discretion of the Trial Court.

The Clerk of Suffolk County shall remove actions No. 24, 25 and 26 from Supreme Court, Suffolk County to Supreme Court, Nassau County.

The Clerk of Nassau County District Court shall remove Action No. 27 from First District Court, Nassau County to Supreme Court, Nassau County, and Action No. 28 from Third District Court, Nassau County to Supreme Court, Nassau County.

The aforesaid files shall be transferred within 10 days of service of a copy of this Order and Notice of Entry.

It shall be the responsibility of each Plaintiff's attorney in actions No. 2 through 28 inclusive, to file an RJI and pay the required fee to the Nassau County Clerk and forward a copy of receipt of same to my Chambers within 30 days of service of a copy of this Order, or those actions without a paid RJI may be dismissed for failure to prosecute in good faith.

All demands for Bills of Particulars and responses to same must be served no later than November 30, 2000.

A Status Conference shall be held on December 7, 2000, at 11:30 A.M., in my Courtroom (Part 16, Third Floor). Counsel thoroughly familiar with these actions must be present. There will be no telephone adjournments.

Commencing on December 12, 2000, at 9:00 A.M., and continuing daily thereafter, the depositions of the Plaintiffs' shall commence at the offices of Milber, Makris, Plousadis and Seiden, LLP, at 990 Stewart Avenue, Suite 600, Garden City, New York. Attorneys' for Defendants' should begin scheduling the Plaintiffs' depositions.

A decision on Movant's request to appoint a Judicial Hearing Officer (JHO) or Court Attorney/Referee to supervise disclosure and/or oversee mediation of the claims is reserved.

A review of the complaints reveals that all 28 lawsuits arise out of the same facts and circumstance. All 28 actions arise from the same transaction, and present common questions of law and fact.

Accordingly, in order to promote judicial economy and avoid the possibility of inconsistent verdicts, consolidation for the purpose of discovery only and JOINT TRIAL is granted. See: Chinatown Apartments v. New York City transit Auth., 100 A.D.2d 824, 474 N.Y. Sup. 2d 763 (1st Dept. 1984); City of New Rochelle v. American Fidelity Fire Insurance Co., at CO, 89 A.D.2d 917 452 N.Y. Sup.2d 230 (2nd Dept. 1982); Animal Feeds Inter'l, Inc. v. Banco Espirito, Inc., 101 Misc.2d 379, 420 N.Y. Sup. 2d 954 (NY CO. 1979).

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE SPECIFIC DIRECTIONS OF THE COURT MAY RESULT IN SANCTIONS AND THE ISSUANCE OF PRECLUSION ORDERS.
