**ORDERED**, that Defendant has this thirty (30) day period to obtain new counsel inasmuch as it cannot proceed *pro se*. CPLR 321 (a); And it is further,

**ORDERED**, that outgoing counsel for Defendant is directed to serve copies of this Order upon Defendant by overnight mail; and it is further,

**ORDERED,** that parties and counsel are directed to appear on June 1, 2001 at 9:15 a.m. for a preliminary conference of this matter.
