Judiciary Law § 468-a and the rules of the Chief Administrator of the Courts (see 22 NYCRR part 118). Petitioner does not object to respondent's application.

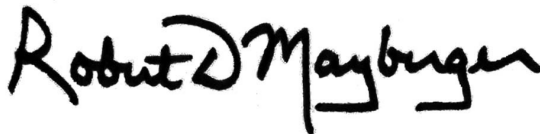
Respondent's application is granted and he is ordered reinstated, effective immediately.
