the Courts (see 22 NYCRR part 118). Petitioner does not object to respondent's application.

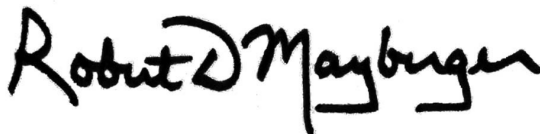
Respondent's application is granted and he is ordered reinstated, effective immediately.
