ORDERED, that Yeshivath Torah Vodaath be and it hereby is granted leave and authority to mortgage and encumber the real property at 425 East 9th Street, in the County of Kings, State of New York to The Bank of Princeton, (the "Lender"), for the purposes set forth in the Petition in consideration of a loan in the amount of \$3,000,000.00 (the "Loan") made by Lender to Mesifta Torah Vodaath ("MTV"), for (i) a term of twenty (20) years, subject to the Lender's call option at the end of the tenth (10th) and fifteenth (15th) years of the term of the Loan, (ii) at an interest rate for five (5) years of 5.75% being 300 basis points above the 5-Year United States Treasury Note, with a floor of 5.75%, and (iii) readjustment of the interest rate in the sixth (6th), eleventh (11th) and sixteenth (16th) years for the succeeding five (5) year periods, each as set forth in the Commitment annexed to the Petition as Exhibit E; and it is further

ORDERED, that the net proceeds of the Loan shall be used by MTV and Yeshivath Torah Vodaath, to pay closing costs and to finance a faculty development program and to make capital improvements to the Property; and it is further

ORDERED, that Yeshivath Torah Vodaath will cause a signed copy of this Order to be delivered to the New York State Attorney General's Office, Charities Bureau, and will notify the New York State Attorney General's Office, Charities Bureau, in writing, when this transaction is completed or abandoned or if it remains pending after ninety (90) days from the date of this Order.
