Per Curiam.

The Attorney Grievance Committee for the Third Judicial Department advises that it does not oppose Eldred's application.

Upon reading the affidavit of Eldred sworn to August 17, 2016, and upon reading the correspondence in response by the Chief Attorney for the Attorney Grievance Committee for the Third Judicial Department, and having determined that Eldred is eligible to resign for nondisciplinary reasons, we grant her application and accept her resignation.

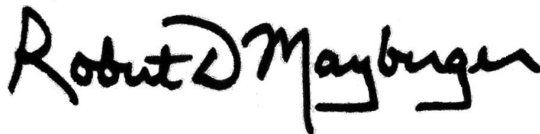
McCarthy, J.P., Garry, Rose, Devine and Mulvey, JJ.,

ORDERED that Alina Dawson Eldred shall, within 30 days of the date of this decision, surrender to the Office of Court Administration any Attorney Secure Pass issued to her.
