The Attorney Grievance Committee for the Third Judicial Department (hereinafter AGC) advises that it does not oppose Kindermann-Roehm's application by correspondence dated March 14, 2018.

Upon reading Kindermann-Roehm's affidavit sworn to May 16, 2017 and filed February 27, 2018, and upon reading the March 14, 2018 correspondence in response by the Chief Attorney for AGC, and having determined that Kindermann-Roehm is eligible to resign

for nondisciplinary reasons, we grant her application and accept her resignation.

ORDERED that Saskia Dagmar Kindermann-Roehm is commanded to desist and refrain from the practice of law in any form in the State of New York, either as principal or as agent, clerk or employee of another; and Kindermann-Roehm is hereby forbidden to appear as an attorney or counselor-at-law before any court, judge, justice, board, commission or other public authority, or to give to another an opinion as to the law or its application, or any advice in relation thereto, or to hold herself out in any way as an attorney and counselor-at-law in this State; and it is further
