Upon reading respondent's affidavit with exhibits sworn to August 31, 2022, the September 30, 2022 responsive correspondence from the Attorney Grievance Committee for the Third Judicial Department and respondent's reply correspondence with exhibit dated October 11, 2022, and having determined, by clear and convincing evidence, that (1) respondent has complied with the order of suspension and the Rules of this Court, (2) respondent has the requisite character and fitness to practice law, and (3) it would be in the public interest to reinstate respondent to the practice of law (*see Matter of Attorneys in Violation of Judiciary Law § 468-a [Toussaint]*, 196 AD3d 830, 830-831 [3d Dept 2021]), it is

ORDERED that respondent's motion for reinstatement is granted; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent is reinstated as an attorney and counselor-at-law, effective immediately.
