Motion by respondent, returnable September 15, 2025, for leave to renew and, upon granting such renewal, (1) vacatur of this Court's June 26, 2025 prior order disbaring him (*Matter of Chesebro*, 239 AD3d 1223 [3d Dept 2025]), and dismissal of the motion by the Attorney Grievance Committee for the Third Judicial Department (hereinafter AGC) for lack of subject-matter jurisdiction (*see* CPLR 5015 [a] [4]; 2221

[e]), and (2) excision from the Court's June 26, 2025 disbarment order (*see Matter of Chesebro*, 239 AD3d 1223 [3d Dept 2025]) all factual findings inconsistent with the Court's obligations under the Full Faith and Credit Clause and Due Process Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment (*see CPLR 2221 [e]*).
